Why do we rotate rodenticides?

While rodenticides are a key tool in managing rodent problems, use of one product or active ingredient doesn't provide enough control. A single bait won't appeal to all rodents, leaving some populations untreated. Target populations become genetically resistant to repeatedly used active ingredients, making single products less effective over time.

Rotating through a series of rodenticides, each with a separate set of active ingredients, can prevent resistance. With each new product, rodents become exposed to different active ingredients and a wider range of bait flavors, textures and scents.
